Dear Fashion Show Team,

Thank you for participating in this year's Sustainability Fashion Show, sponsored by Housing and Residence Life's Office of Sustainability and sponsored by the Student Office of Sustainability! Just Bag It Fashion Show: Rules for 2019

The fashion outfit must be made **entirely** out of recycled or repurposed items. This **includes** the assessment of accessories such as bags, jewelry, shoes, etc. for the above requirement. A *small* amount of tape, glue, hot glue, and/or staples may be used. Used clothing can be repurposed but must be redesigned. For instance, a T-shirt can be cut up to make a head band or a bracelet or bag, but it can't be a shirt.

Each outfit will be judged on (with each category 5 points for a total of 20 points):

1. Creativity and innovation: This includes novel uses of materials - using a sustainability theme as a basis for the design.
2. Execution: How well made is the costume? Is the model able to walk easily? Do the pieces of the outfit go together? Do the pieces stay together during the runway appearance?
3. Quantity of materials used: How many different types of repurposed or recycled materials are used to make the outfit? Are there items used that are unusual?
4. Presentation: How well does the model present the outfit on the runway? (Models will have the opportunity to come early and rehearse on the runway so they are comfortable with walking on the stage.)

Additional rules:

1. **One model** per each team.
2. In order for us to know how many contestants to accommodate for, **your team may not withdraw from the competition after Wednesday, April 17th 2019**. If you choose to withdraw from the show after this date, you will disqualify your hall in the Caught Green Handed Competition.
3. The model will be required to wear/work the outfit on the runway in front of the judges in order to be scored.
4. **A written description and photos of the model wearing the outfit showing the front and back must be provided by Wednesday, April 17th 2019 and emailed to wagamame6626@uwec.edu**. The description should be a minimum of 150 words but *no more than 300 words*. (If a description or picture is not submitted, the contestant may be subject to removal from the competition). **The description will be read during the model's runway appearance**, so make sure it is appropriate for an audience of all ages.
5. In your description, please provide the names (and pronunciation) of your design team and model. Please include the following in your description:
 - i. **The materials included in the outfit**
 - ii. **The inspiration behind the outfit**
 - iii. **The amount of time (days, consecutive/total hours, whichever you prefer to list) it took to create the outfit**
 - iv. **Anything else you'd like to share with the judges and audience!**
